Wow, I cannot believe how quickly the first month of school has gone by. We have been busy learning our classroom rules and routines, recognizing and printing our names, exploring colours, printing numbers and representing number sets, identifying shapes in our environment, and figuring out how join in play and how to solve the conflicts that arise during play.

The month of October is always a busy and exciting time. We will continue to focus on fall, as understanding seasonal changes is part of the kindergarten science curriculum. We will also spend some time sharing about our families. The children are each to bring a family photo for show and share this month (send to school on your child's special helper day, not earlier), to be displayed in our room for the year. I strongly feel that young children should understand that all families are different and accepted in our society. Over the month we will be reading stories where different types of families are depicted: nuclear, single parent, same sex parents, foster, and blended families. I believe that if children are exposed to different family types when they are young they will grow up more accepting of differences. If you do not want your child to read or discuss any of these types of books please let me know in writing by October 8th, your child can read an alternate book with one of our educational assistants during these story times.
As we get closer to the end of the month, our focus will likely shift to Halloween. I always ask the students if they want to focus on Halloween or continue with our learning project (i.e. fall). We will have a class pumpkin party, and I will send home more information mid-month. If you are able to volunteer in our classroom on Halloween please let me know as soon as possible. I like to have parents run the Halloween centers this day, and of course, you can come in costume :)
